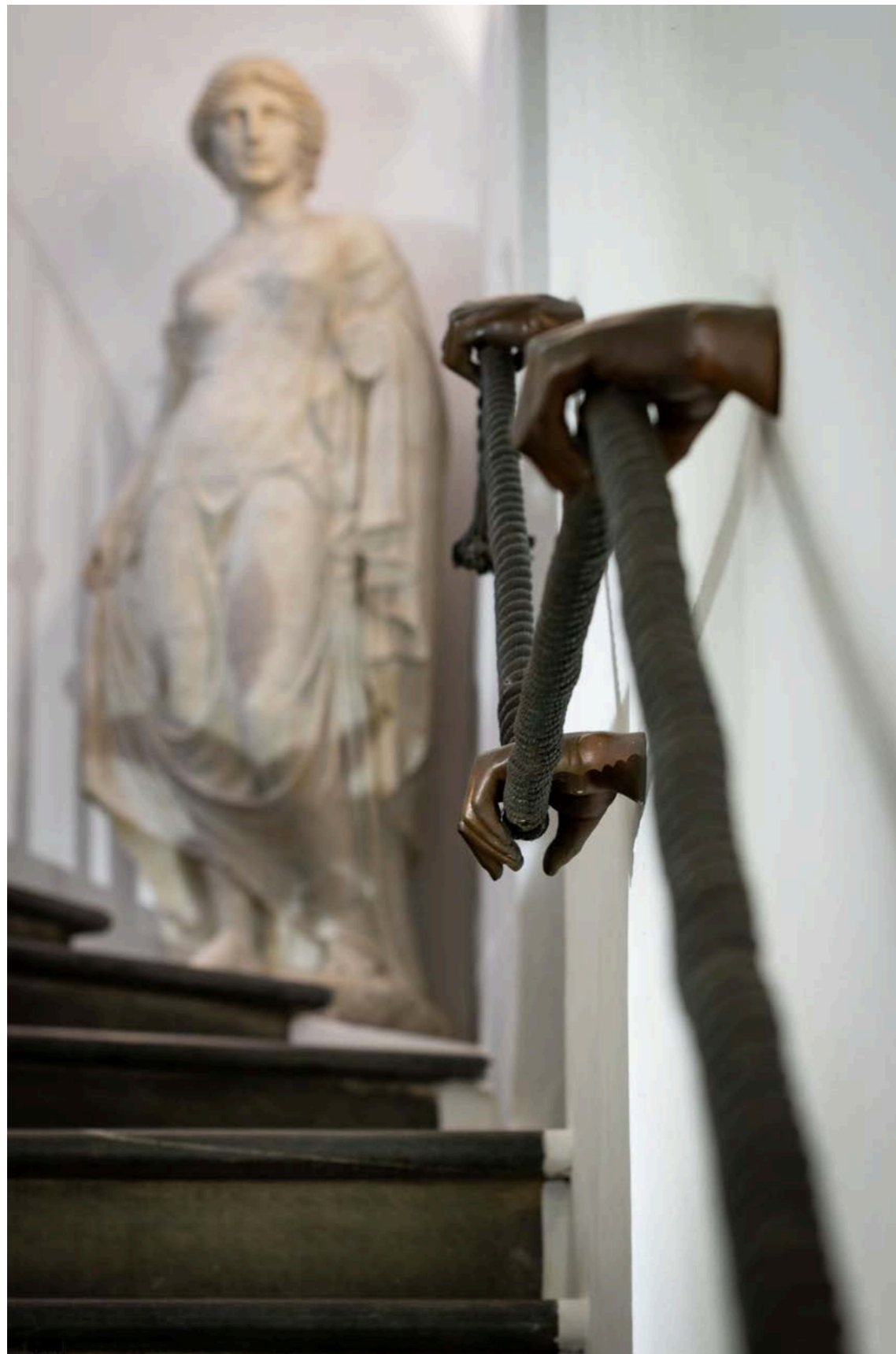




## *The Art Gallery*

From the large terrace you can admire the woods and the waterfall of the Villa, framed by the slender Tuscan trees.

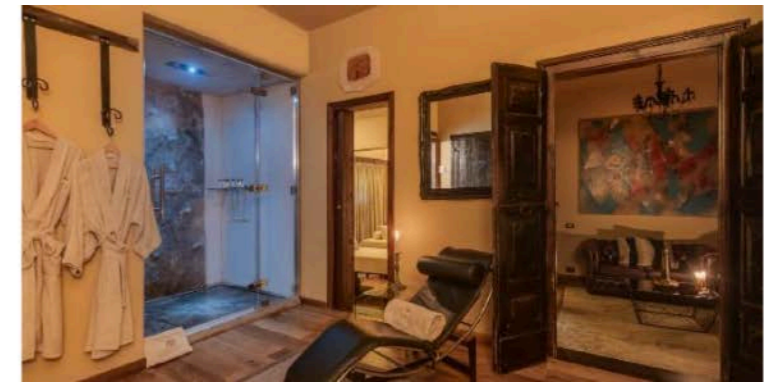
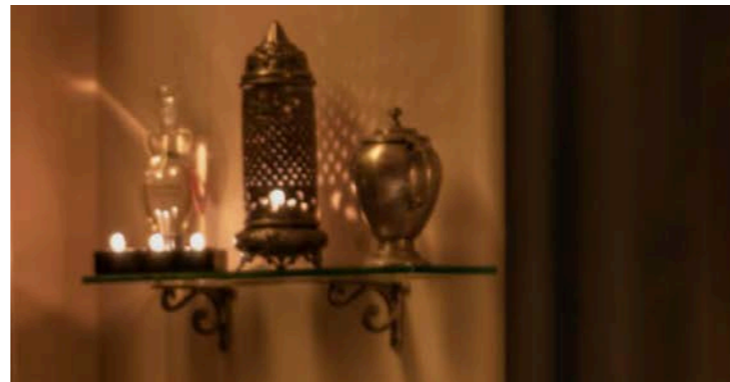
This suite features a custom-made spiral case which gently invites guests to the loft living space above.

Make a masterpiece out of yourself - Il Bottaccio has created an oasis of well-being around this philosophy - a luxury boutique spa where body and soul reflect one another.



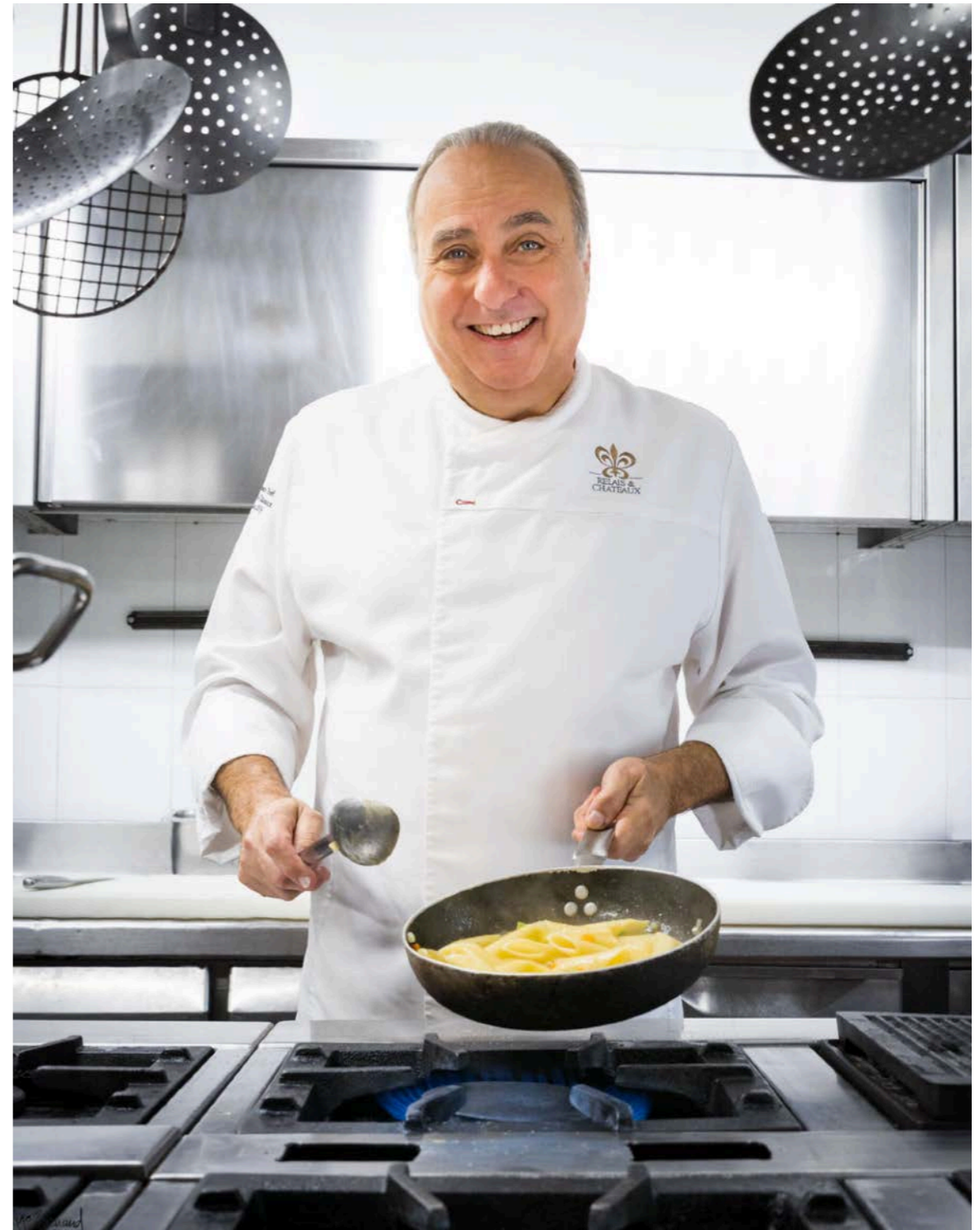




## *Nino Mosca*

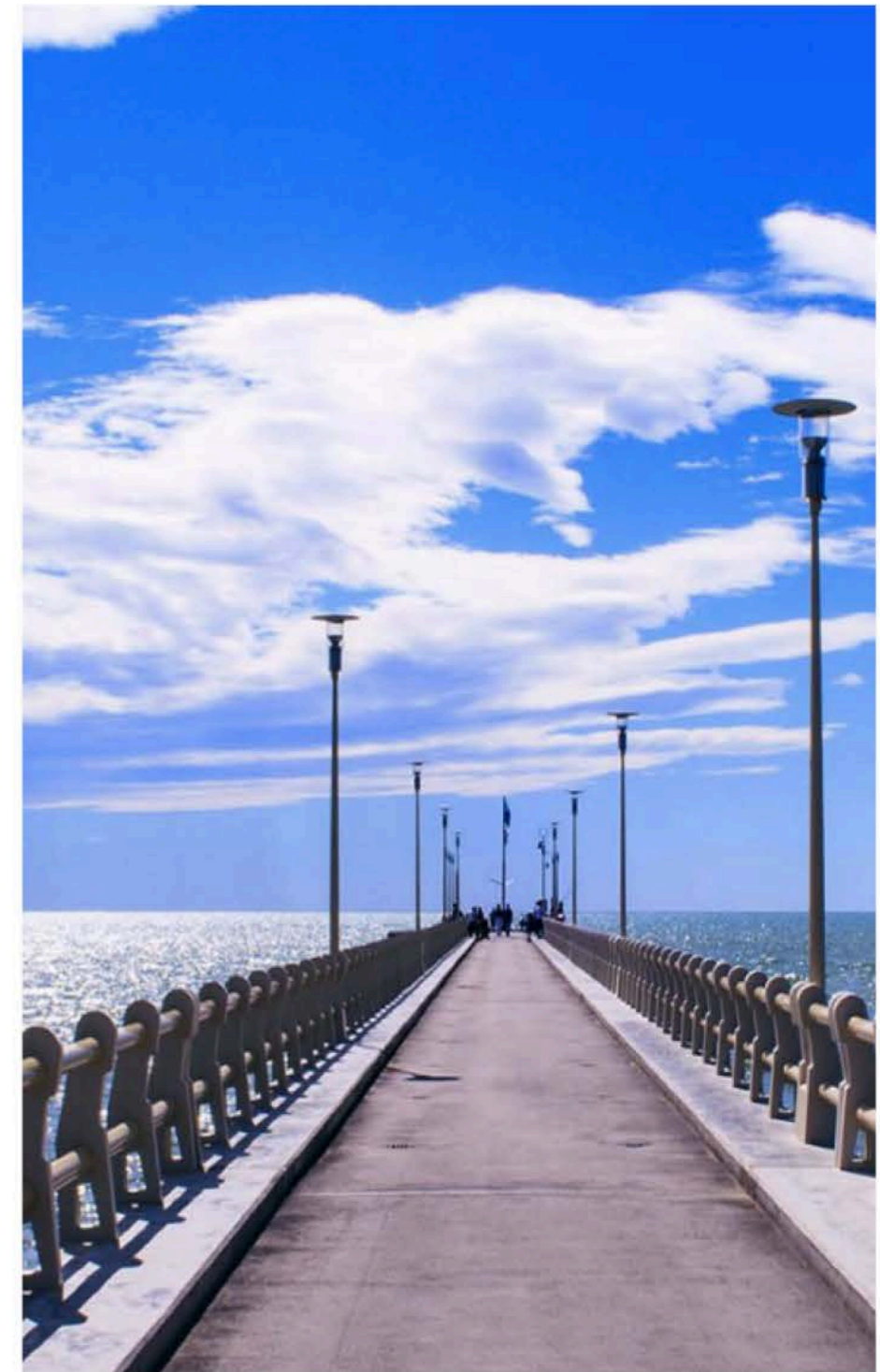
## *Cooking School*

## *Forte dei Marmi*

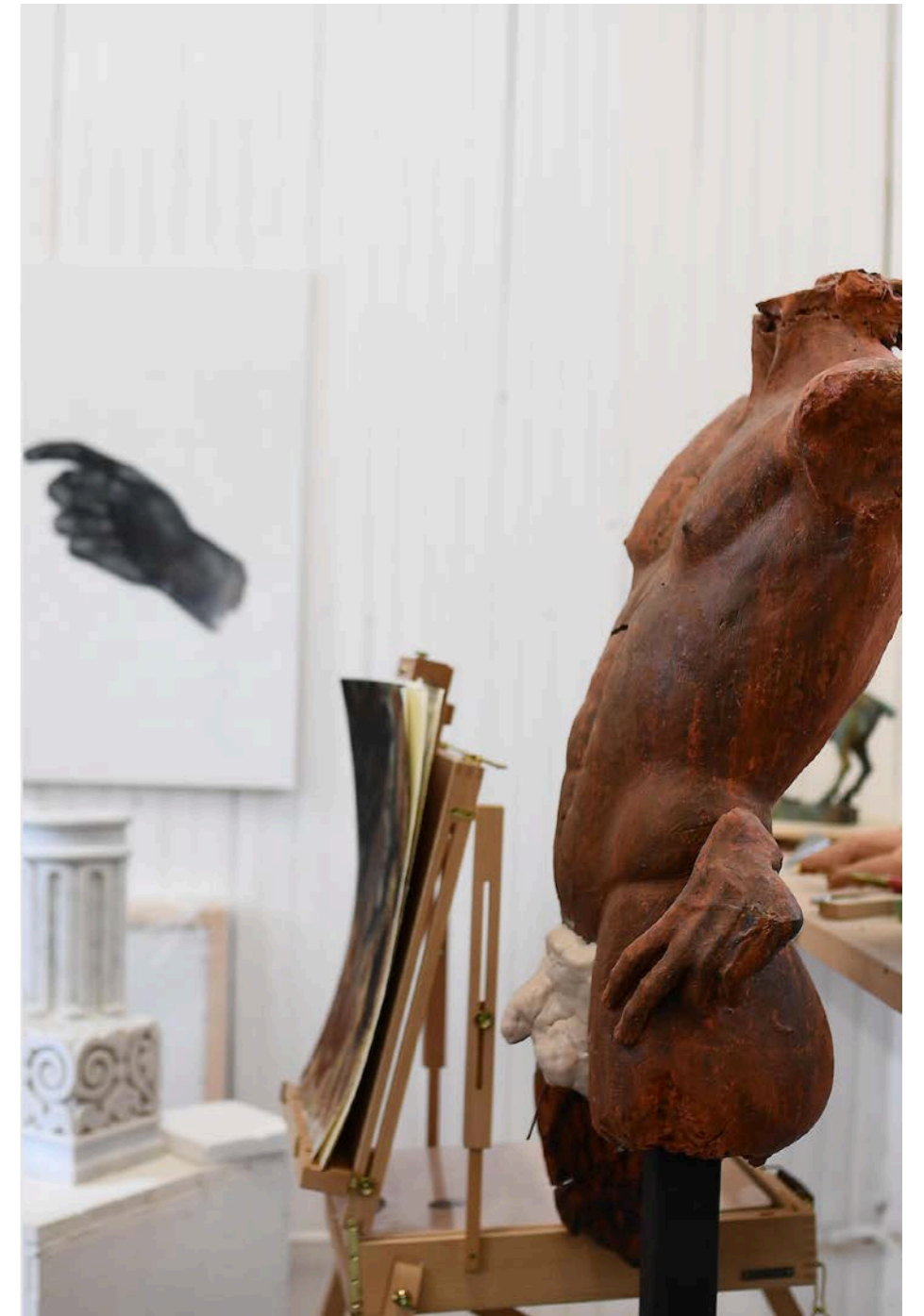

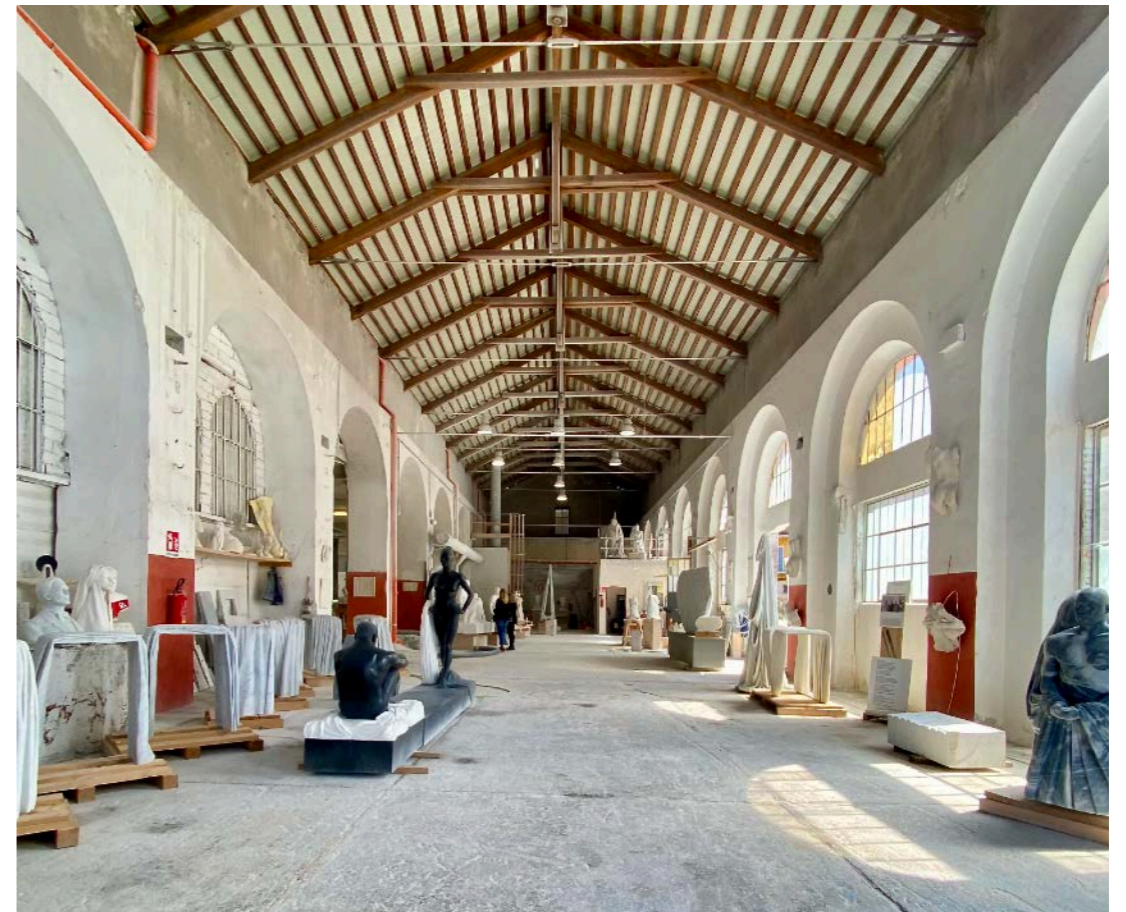
## *Pietrasanta*

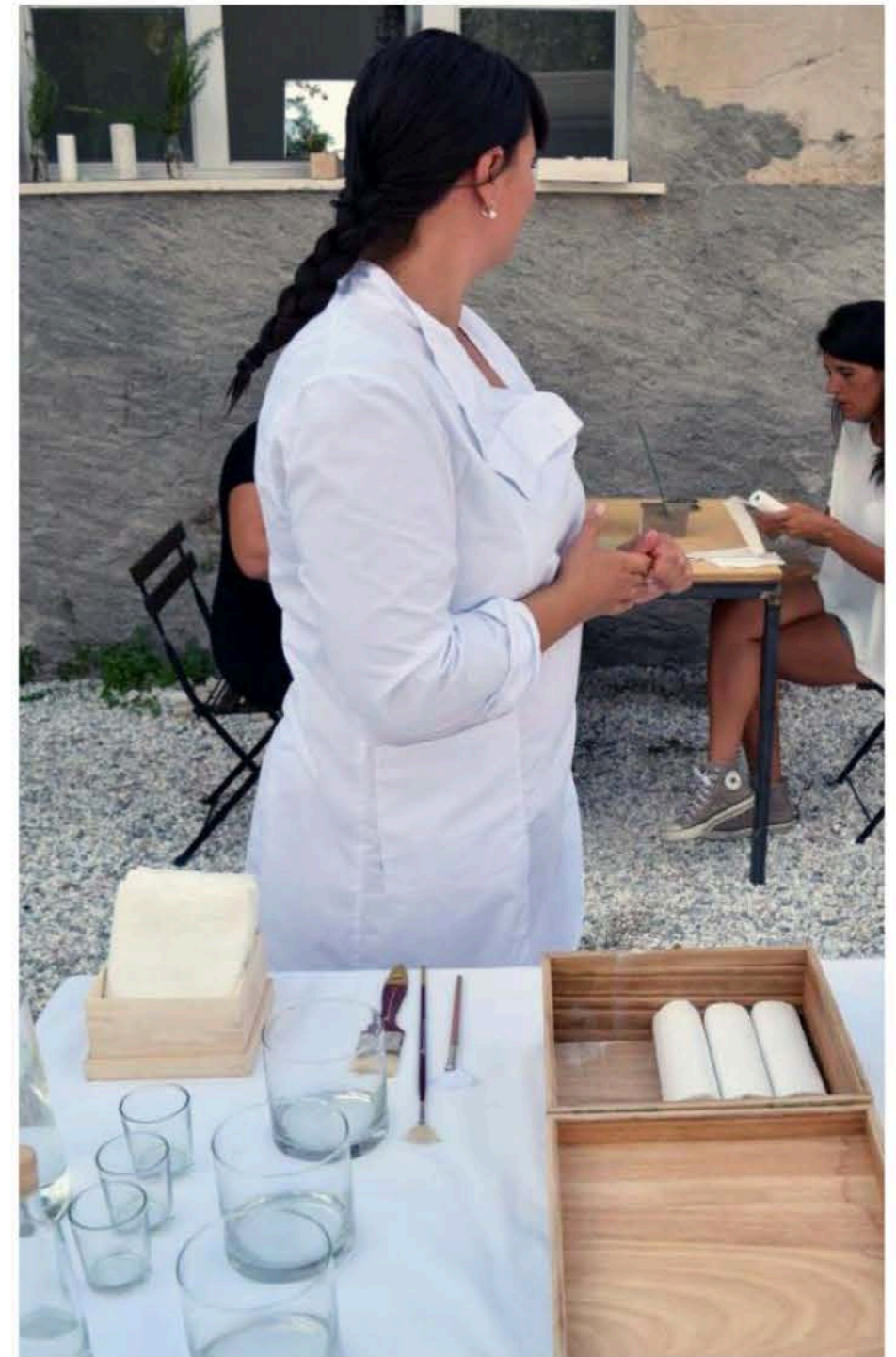

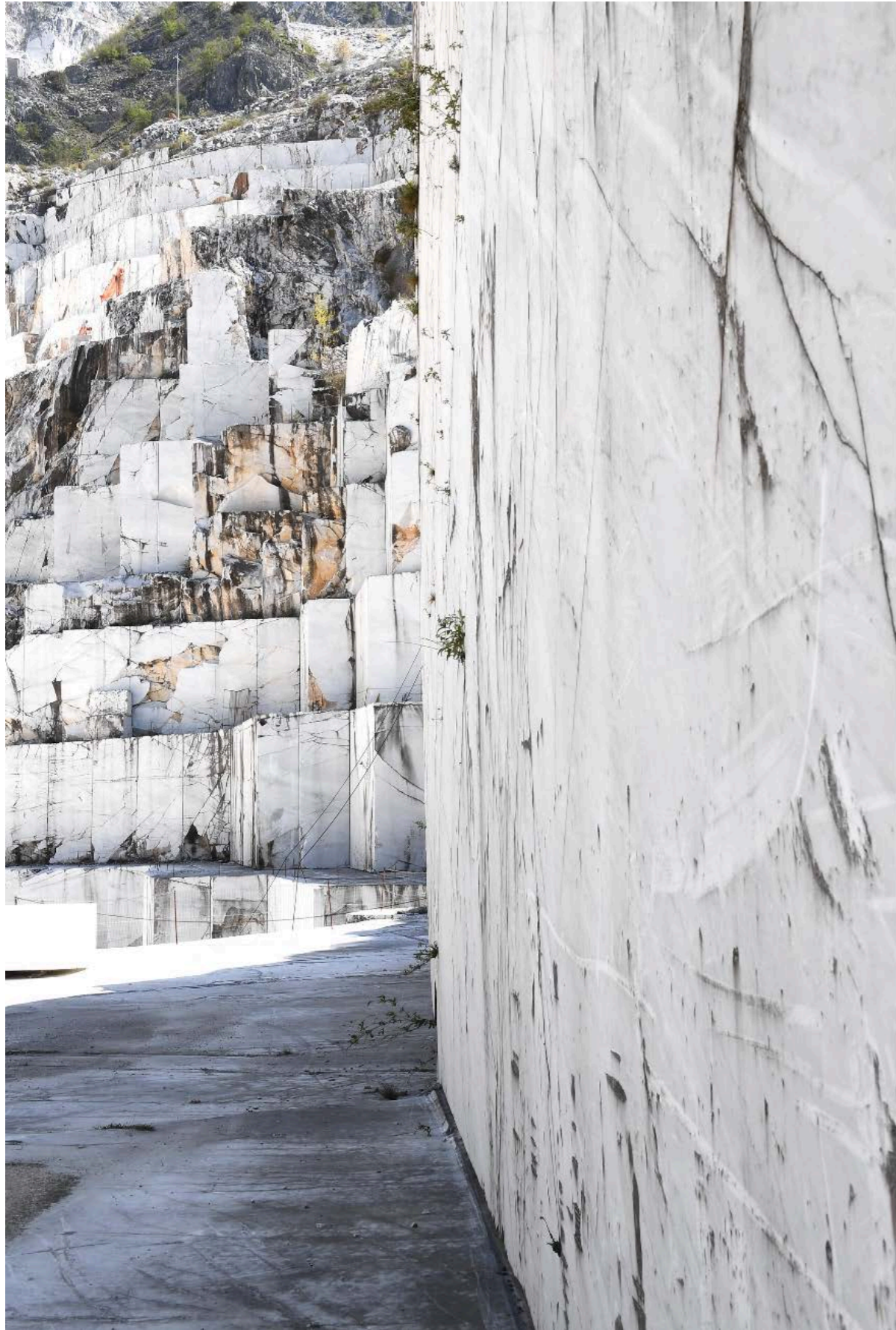


*Create your own

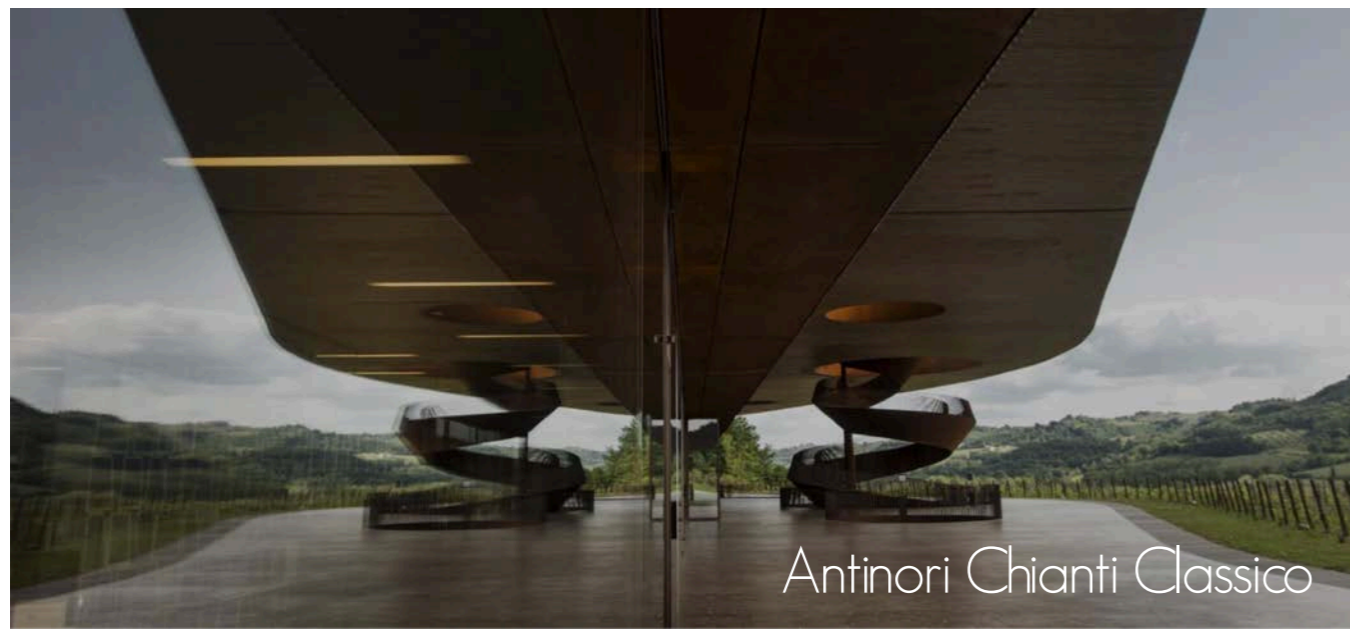
