## day 1 / day 2 / day 3

Arrival in Bari and private transfer to Monopoli, where guests check in at **Tenuta Legaro Boutique Hotel**, a beautifully restored historic wine estate nestled in the Apulian countryside.

In the late afternoon, enjoy a sunset stroll through **Monopoli's** charming old town, with its limestone alleys, fishing harbor, and golden Adriatic light. Discover the dramatic cliffs of **Polignano a Mare**, perched above crystal-clear waters. An optional private boat experience allows guests to explore the spectacular sea caves from a privileged perspective.

Continue inland to the Fasano countryside for an immersive olive oil tasting among centuries-old olive trees — a true connection to the land and its traditions. Explore **Ostuni**, the iconic "White City," wandering through its maze of whitewashed alleys. Guests may choose to enhance the experience with a private cooking class or a visit to a local artisan atelier. In **Bari**, discover the vibrant historic center and meet the local ladies of Bari Vecchia as they prepare traditional orecchiette by hand — an authentic and heartwarming encounter.

At Tenuta Legaro, enjoy a curated wine tasting experience, celebrating the estate's own vineyards and the rich winemaking heritage of Puglia.

A scenic transfer leads to Taranto, where guests check in at the carefully restored historic **Relais Histó Hotel & SPA**.


Visit to **Grottaglie**. In the late afternoon, wander through the atmospheric old town set on its island between two seas, followed by a sunset aperitivo overlooking the water — an intimate and evocative moment. Discover the elegance of **Martina Franca**, renowned for its graceful baroque architecture and hidden courtyards, before continuing to **Alberobello** to explore its UNESCO-listed trulli district — a fairytale landscape of white stone dwellings with conical roofs. A full day is devoted to **Lecce**, often referred to as the “Florence of the South.” Enjoy a private guided tour of its extraordinary baroque masterpieces, followed by a visit to a traditional papier-mâché artisan workshop, where centuries-old craftsmanship is still practiced with passion.

The journey culminates with a day excursion to **Matera**. Explore the ancient Sassi districts with a private guide, step inside a historic cave dwelling, and savor a panoramic lunch carved into the rock — an unforgettable experience suspended between history and landscape.
