The tour will be managed by a staff: **1 or 2 guides and 1 mechanic/driver**.

The guides support the guests both in the cycling experience and in the leisure experiences and will manage the logistics of the guests.

The mechanic manages the good functioning of the bicycles and will take care of the well-being of the guests on the bike with water, isotonic dinks, coke, nuts, dried fruits.

The broom service will also be managed which allows the guest, if he feels tired, at any time during the journey, to get on the van to return to the hotel.





The historic Apulian Aqueduct – Long





The historic Apulian Aqueduct – Short








Grottaglie ceramics tour – Long


Grottaglie ceramics tour – Short


Itria, the “Trulli” valley (UNESCO site) – Long

The figs of Pomona Gardens




A 10-hectare garden of rare beauty, with a large collection of "Ficus carica," a very important species in the Mediterranean basin. We'll learn how to "**maritare**" dried figs: first, harvesting the figs, then opening them and arranging them on traditional drying racks, and finally "**maritatura**" them with toasted almonds and lemon zest.

The unmissable Cibus must be sought in the maze of alleys of the historic center of Ceglie, it is idyllic to sit at the tables of the small internal courtyard. 


La Cuccagna Giro di Vite Restaurant

Martino Marsella founded the restaurant in 1969 as an extension of the traditional butcher's shop with the "Fornello Pronto Pugliese." Today, meat remains the highlight of many dishes, paired with fresh vegetables, refined appetizers and main courses. An elegant, curated cuisine where every preparation reflects local selection and excellent products.

Osteria Piazzetta Cattedrale

We're in Ostuni, the "White City," just meters from the cathedral. A wife in the kitchen and a husband in the dining room run this place like a little gem. From the floors to the chandeliers, everything is as elegant as a refined living room. The dishes pay homage to regional products. An example? Lasagne with Apulian ragù, caciocavallo cheese, and basil, or zuccotto with ricotta ice cream, almonds, and fig ham.



Gatto Rosso restaurant

In the heart of Taranto, chef Agostino Bartoli offers well-executed contemporary cuisine based on genuine fish. Everything revolves around the freshness of the raw material and the exaltation of the final product, without excessive elaborations. Starting from the Taranto tradition, we return to the essence and authenticity. The environment is well-kept and comfortable, with an attentive service and a fine wine cellar.
